

REACH Regulation (European Regulation for Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals).

The REACH Regulation (n. 1907/2006) concerning the Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of chemical substances is for ALL the effects entered into force on **1st June 2008**.

In accordance with the provisions of REACH, those who produce or who import from non-EU countries a substance as such or contained in a preparation, in a quantity equal to or greater than one ton per year, will have the obligation to "register" it at the European Chemical Agency with different methods and timelines depending on the quantity produced / imported and the dangerousness of the substance. Starting from **January 5 2021**, information on articles containing substances of very high concern (present in the candidate list) in a concentration greater than 0.1% w / w and placed on the EU market must be sent to ECHA via the SCIP database.

As a result, the FFGI. Srl believes to inform its customers as follows:

1 - PRE-REGISTRATION AND REGISTRATION POLICY

The FFGI. Srl does not produce or import chemical substances (as such or components of preparations or articles), therefore it is not required to pre-register and register. However, as substance users, we have an interest and need to receive information from our suppliers.

2 - POLICY CONCERNING THE SUPPLIERS

It was our pleasure to contact all the suppliers of raw materials to know their understanding regarding the continuity of the supplies. All carried out the PRE-REGISTRATION of all the substances treated.

3 - PRESENCE OF HIGH-RISK SUBSTANCES (SVHC)

None of the products manufactured or distributed by our company contains HIGH RISK SUBSTANCES (SVHC) - see list published on the ECHA website
